Do not forget it.... May you always be friends and apostles of Jesus Christ!"

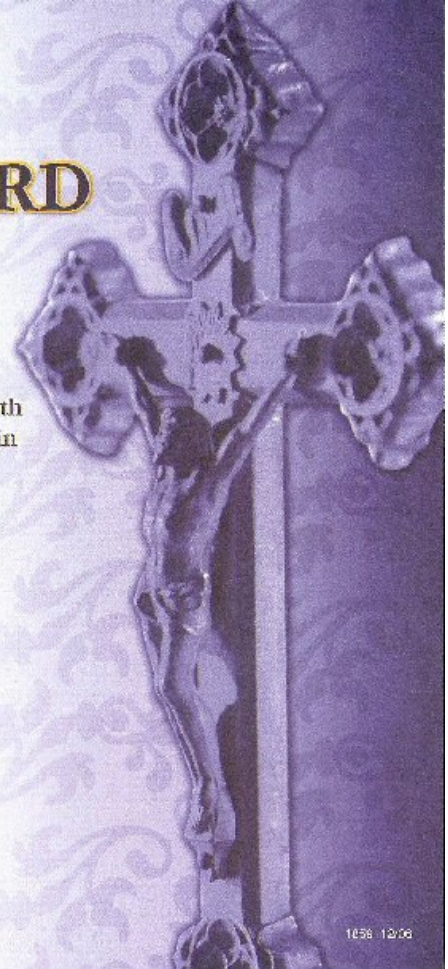
